As I completed this map project, I remembered to (place a check mark next to each item if done):

- Use regular leaded pencil to label everything. You may go over the pencil with a fine-point blue or black pen or marker.
- Use colored pencils to shade in each country.
- Make sure the coloring is uniform and neatly done.
- Make sure labeling is neatly done.
- Make sure everything is spelled correctly.

1. Place a check mark in the circle next to each country indicating that it is labeled in **capital letters, spelled correctly and you colored** each country a different color or make sure that countries that border each other are a different color. (**14 countries, example: JORDAN**)

2. Place a second check mark to the right of each country indicating that you correctly labeled and spelled the capital city of each country of the Middle East.

3. Place a check mark next to all oceans, seas, bays, gulfs, and straits (**18 bodies of water**). The check mark indicates that they are labeled on the map, in the correct location and are correctly spelled.

7. Place a check mark next to the following physical features and islands indicating that they are labeled and spelled correctly. (**4 things**).

- Arabian Peninsula
- Crete
- Sinai Peninsula
- Zagros Mountains
- With a florescent highlighter, highlight the outer boundary of the Arabian Peninsula.

8. A check mark indicates that you:

- Drew a **key** (also called a legend) on your map just like the one on **page 93** of the *National Geographic Student Atlas of the World*.
- Included at least the **three symbols** used in the atlas.
- Made sure it is neat and orderly.

- Designed and drew a compass rose.
- Included the four cardinal points (north, south, east, and west)
