<u>Vista's White Mountain Overnight Equipment List</u> <u>For Duffel or Extra Pack</u>

We will be camping for two days. During that time, our clothing and equipment will be our shelter . Having warm clothes can mean the difference between a great time and a miserable experience. You must have every item listed below except the optional items. It is important that you make every attempt to borrow any equipment you do not own. Clothing must not contain cotton. Cotton, once it is damp or wet, wicks heat away from your body and does not dry quickly. Synthetic materials such as polypro, fleece, and other materials are a better choice in the mountains.

sleeping bag (packed in two trash bags to keep it dry)
tent (if you are the one providing it; minimum 2-person, maximum 4-person)
duffel bag or extra backpack to pack your extra non-hiking clothes in
trash bag to line your pack or duffel to keep things in it dry
extra long underwear (tops and bottoms)
extra long pants
extra turtleneck or long-sleeve shirt
extra fleece jackets or wool sweaters
extra wool or synthetic socks (2 pairs)
extra wool or synthetic ski hat
extra shorts (1 pair)
extra T-shirt (2)
sneakers, for in camp
