

Agenda Town Meeting Wednesday, October 10, 2012
Purpose: Design a functional set of democratic guidelines for Team Vista.

- Over the weeks, you have been learning to work together through games; challenges; hikes on Friday; setting up tents; working in your group on the spider challenge; and discussions in pairs; hiking groups and as a basecamp.
- You have probably begun to notice where potential problems could arise, and we think you are now ready to think through strategies that will lessen and avoid these difficulties.
- But first, what do you think have been some difficulties in getting everyone working on any or all of the above mentioned things we have done so far this year?
- We have already discussed what it takes to be a successful student and brainstormed, discussed, and reached consensus as to our affirmations.

Individually, create 3-5 guidelines that are the most important for our team to follow to be successful this year.

- **Next, what guidelines do we need to establish to ensure we all get the maximum opportunity to achieve our full potential to have a fully democratic society on this team.**
 - Give as an individual question first
 - Individual responses are discussed brought to consensus in a hiking group/basecamp.
 - Hiking group/basecamp present to whole team.
- A committee then is given the charge to draft a bill of rights to be submitted to the team.
 - At least two drafts will be made before bringing it to ratification by the team.

Always remember our process:

1. We ask you what is your individual idea.
2. Share and combine that in hiking group .
3. Share and combine in basecamp.
4. Share and combine as whole team.
