Nature Journal Rubric and Current Conditions Checklist

For the overnight hike on Thursday and the nature journals and Friday hikes and nature journals, four grades will usually be given for:

Effort

- Work quality
- Citizenship/cooperation
- Practice/preparedness

•Only **pencil** and **colored pencil** are used.

All parts are **numbered**—see your current conditions handout taped into your nature journal.

Current Conditions Checklist:

- Thoroughly describes the weather conditions in **detail**. Your written description should be 6 to 10 thoughtful sentences using no repetitions; proofread your response aloud for GUMS.
- Uses five (5) senses and writes about the sounds, looks, smells, what you feel, and tastes **compared to the last time**.
- Details and specifics are evident.
- **E**—**Expert in the Field**, all criteria has been thoroughly met and of expert quality—neatness and organization.
- **M—University Naturalist**, all of the criteria has been met and is generally high quality.
- **P—Student Naturalist**, most of the criteria has been met and is acceptable quality.
- **N—Backyard Naturalist**, many parts were missing or not acceptable showing little effort.

Circled or highlighted text indicates that something was missing, lacking, or did not meet the criteria indicated.
