What You Need In A Well Written Paragraph

- Topic Sentence
 - Main point of the paragraph.
 - Helps the reader figure out what you are talking about.
- Every paragraph has supporting details such as...
 - Facts—something that can be proven.
 - An example—a specific one.
 - Sensory details—they appeal to the senses:
 - smell
 - taste
 - touch
 - hearing
 - sight
- Summation Statement
 - Wraps-up the idea—does not repeat

***Use signal words to help make connections of your ideas clear to the reader.**
