- 1. **benevolent: adjective:** desiring to do good for others; generous.
- 2. **comrade: noun:** 1. a close friend who shares one's chief interests. 2. a fellow member of an organization, especially of the Communist party.
- 3. **confinement: noun:** the state of being confined; imprisonment.
- 4. **cynical: adjective:** showing little or no faith in human nature; distrustful or contemptuous of others' motives.
- 5. **ensconce: transitive verb:** 1. to position (oneself) firmly or comfortably. 2. to hide or cover, as for protection.
- 6. **laborious:** adjective: requiring considerable effort or perseverance.
- 7. **rebellion: noun:** 1. an uprising or armed resistance against established authority or a government. 2. resistant defiance against what is conventional or restrictive.
- 8. **scullery: noun:** a room adjoining a kitchen, or a part of a pantry, where dishes and utensils are cleaned and stored, or preliminary food preparation is done.
- 9. **slogan: noun:** a short phrase used to summarize a principle or political message or to advertise a product; motto.
- 10. knacker: noun: a person who buys worn-out or old livestock and slaughters them to sell their meat or hides.
